



The Larry Sommers Art Fellowship

Seattle Print Arts is pleased to announce the first annual fellowship in memory of Larry Sommers.

The purpose of this fellowship is to support artistic excellence in the areas of print arts, book arts and works on or of paper. The award will provide a stipend of \$2,000 to produce new work or to support a project in progress. The selected artist will be determined by the artistic excellence of the work presented in the application by a panel of arts professionals connected with the fellowship committee of Seattle Print Arts. In addition to the monetary award, the chosen artist will receive a one-year Seattle Print Arts membership.

Dates:

- Deadline for entries: Tuesday June 1st, 2010. * See note below
- Jury date: June 15, 2010
- Announcement of award: August 2010
- Completion of project and artist's talk within one year of award.

Application Requirements:

- Open to professional artists. Students pursuing a degree in fine art are also eligible.
- Selection will be based on the artistic excellence of work submitted with a focus on print arts, paper or artists books.

Submit the following: *Include your name and contact information on all materials.*

1. CD of IMAGES

A maximum of 10 jpegs of work completed in the past two years on a CD. Each image must be labeled with the artist's last name and file number corresponding to an annotated image list that includes title, medium and dimension of work.

2. WRITTEN MATERIALS

One paragraph on how the artist will use the award.

A one paragraph artist's statement.

A one-page resume.

3. A check for the \$15 application fee made out to *Seattle Print Arts* must be included with the application.

4. Enclose a stamped, self-addressed envelope if you would like your CD returned.

The selected artist will be required to give a talk to the Seattle Print Arts membership upon completion of the project no later than a year after receiving the award. Out of state artists will make other arrangements for a presentation if travel to Seattle is not possible.

* Deadline for entries: Tuesday, June 1st, 2010. This is not a postmark deadline. Seattle Print Arts, 1122 E. Pike St., Ste 1444 Seattle, WA 98122. Submissions may be hand-delivered to that address. It is "Post Options" on Pike. Note: Monday is Memorial Day.
